On October 16, 2020 at approximately 9:50 am, Nashua Police Department Patrol Officers arrested Nicholas Jewett, age 29, of 99 North Road, Brentwood, NH and charged with him with one count of Identity Fraud, Class A Felony, and one count of Theft by Deception, Class A Felony.

On August 23, 2020 the Nashua Police Department was notified by Budget Rent-A-Car that a subject who rented a vehicle from them had posed as an unknowing victim and produced fictitious documents with the victim's name. As a result of this, Budget Rent-A-Car reported the vehicle stolen. The investigation was furthered by Detectives assigned to the Criminal Investigation Division. During the course of the investigation Nicholas Jewett was identified as the suspect. It was determined Jewett posed as an individual to rent a vehicle and that he had no intention of returning the vehicle. Based on the information received during the course of the investigation, Detectives completed an arrest warrant charging Jewett with Identity Fraud, Class A Felony.

Each Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Jewett refused bail and is being held at the Rockingham County Department of Correction pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough Superior Court-South on October 19, 2020.
