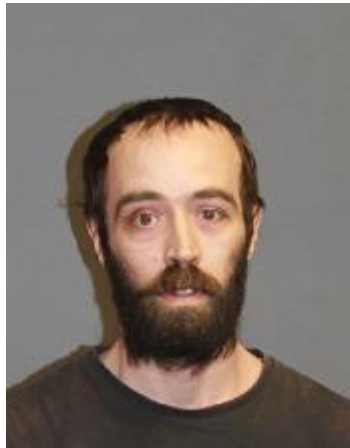

On January 26, 2018 at approximately 8:51PM, William Oakes, age 36, of 5 Bay Street, Hudson, NH was arrested by Officers of the Problem Oriented Policing Unit of the Nashua Police Department. Oakes is charged with one count of Receiving Stolen Property, Class A Felony.

On November 9, 2017, the Nashua Police Department Uniform Patrol Operations Bureau took a report of a burglary that had occurred within Nashua, NH. During this burglary, multiple jewelry and other personal items were taken. The Criminal Investigation Division furthered this investigation and learned that multiple items taken from the burglary were pawned at a Nashua store on November 16, 2017. Oakes was identified as the person responsible for pawning this stolen property.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. William Oakes received a \$10,000.00 Cash or Surety bail and will be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court - South on January 29, 2018.
