On September 5, 2019 at approximately 2:23 pm officers from Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Chad Everette, age 41, of No Fixed Address for Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug, 2nd Offense, Felony.

In May of 2019 members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division began an investigation into Chad Everette, 41, of No Fixed Address. During this investigation Detectives learned that Everette was selling various illicit narcotics within the City of Nashua. Based upon information developed during this investigation, Detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Everette and he was taken into custody.

Everette was charged with two count of Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug (Heroin), 2nd Offense, Felony, two counts of Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug (Crack Cocaine), 2nd Offense, Felony, Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug (Cocaine), 2nd Offense, Felony, and Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug (Marijuana), 2nd Offense, Felony. Everette was also charged with Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer, Class B Felony based on an investigation that was conducted by members of the Uniformed Field Operations Bureau. Everette will be arraigned at Hillsborough County Superior Court South on September 6, 2019.
