On June 12, 2022, at approximately 1:41 pm, members of the Nashua Police Department's Special Weapons and Tactics Unit (SWAT), arrested Andrew Lennartson, age 25, of Nashua, New Hampshire. Lennartson was arrested on an arrest warrant charging him with First Degree Assault (Firearm), a Special Felony. After he was placed into custody Lennartson was additionally charged with Attempted First Degree Assault, 2 Counts, Special Felony, Reckless Conduct (Firearm), Felonious Use of Firearms, both Class B Felonies.

On June 12, 2022, at approximately 12:58 a.m., members of the Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to Casa Vieja Mexican Grill located at 96 Main Street for the report of a person shot. Patrol officers encountered a chaotic scene upon arrival and an adult male with a single gunshot wound. The victim was transported to a local hospital with serious injuries. Detectives from the Criminal Investigation Division furthered the investigation and developed Lennartson as the suspect responsible for the shooting. Detectives sought, and were granted an arrest warrant charging Andrew Lennartson with First Degree Assault – a Special Felony.

A Felony is punishable by a term of imprisonment in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Lennartson was held on preventative detention pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court - Southern District on June 13, 2022.
