On January 12, 2021, the Nashua Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division arrested Manuel Escamilla, age 28, of 3 Roedean Drive, Nashua, New Hampshire 03064. Manuel was charged with one (1) count of Robbery – Class A Felony and one (1) count of Convicted Felons – Class B Felony.

On January 8, 2021, at 7:55 A.M., patrol officers responded to the report of an Armed Robbery that occurred at Studio on Pearl located at 101 West Pearl Street. Patrol Officers learned that a masked male had entered the store and demanded money from one of the hairdressers while brandishing a knife. The suspect obtained cash from the hairdresser and then fled the area. No one was injured during the Robbery. Detectives with the Criminal Investigation Division were notified and furthered the investigation. With assistance from the Problem Oriented Policing Unit, the male suspect was identified as Manuel Escamilla. Detectives completed an arrest warrant and Escamilla was taken into custody on January 12, 2021.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen (15) years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven (7) years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Manuel was held on a preventative detention order pending his arraignment at Hillsborough County Superior Court – Southern District on January 13, 2021.
