On February 27, 2018 at approximately 7:54 PM, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau, Patrol Division, arrested Shawn Chase, age 35, of 6 Strawberry Bank Road, Apartment 13, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Duty to Inform, Class B Felony.

The Nashua Police Department learned a convicted Sex Offender had moved out of an address in Nashua without properly updating his Sex Offender Registration information. An investigation was initiated by the Special Investigations Division. Following the Detective's investigation, it was determined that Chase failed to report a change to his information as required and a warrant was obtained for his arrest. Chase was charged with one count of Duty to Inform, a Class B Felony.

Chase was convicted of multiple counts of Violation of Privacy from Milford District Court, Milford, New Hampshire on March 4, 2015. Based on that conviction, Chase is required to register quarterly as a Tier III Sex Offender for the remainder of his life.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Chase was released on \$200 cash bail pending his arraignment on March 15, 2018.
