On November 23, 2018 at approximately 9:50 AM members of the Nashua Police Departments Uniform Patrol Division arrested Kevin Olena, age 33, of 4 Williams Ct. Nashua, New Hampshire for Burglary, Class B Felony, Violation of Protection Order, Stalking; Domestic Violence, Breach of Bail, Criminal Mischief, and Resisting Arrest, all Class A Misdemeanors.

On November 23, 2018, the Nashua Police Department responded to a residence in Nashua for a report of a Violation of Protection Order. It was reported Olena entered a residence of a person known to him without permission. Additionally, there was a protection order in place along with bail conditions from a previous arrest which prevented Olena from having contact with the victim or being at their residence. Olena was located by patrol officers at the residence and was taken into custody after a brief struggle. The Special Investigations Division was notified of this incident and furthered the investigation.

A Class B felony is punishable by up to 7 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines and a Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to 1 year in the Hillsborough County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Olena is being held pending his arraignment at Hillsborough Superior Court South on November 26, 2018.
