New Hampshire Attorney General Gordon J. MacDonald and Nashua Police Chief Andrew J. Lavoie announce further information concerning an investigation in Nashua, New Hampshire that began on July 8, 2018.

Just after midnight on July 8<sup>th</sup>, Nashua Police responded to a 911 call at 19 Buck Street for a reported deceased male. Upon arrival, they discovered David Smith, age 49, deceased inside his home.

On July 9<sup>th</sup>, an autopsy was performed on Mr. Smith by Chief Medical Examiner Jennie V. Duval. Dr. Duval determined that Mr. Smith's cause of death was a single gunshot wound and the manner of death was a homicide.
