On March 27, 2018 at approximately 5:39 PM, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau, Patrol Division, arrested Paul Morris, age 62, of 36 Chandler Street, Apartment 1C, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Registration of Online Identifiers, Class B Felony.

The Nashua Police Department discovered a convicted Sex Offender had failed to report online identifiers on his Sex Offender Registration as required. An investigation was initiated by the Special Investigations Division and it was verified that Paul Morris, failed to notify the Nashua Police Department of a social media account on his Sex Offender Registration. As a result, Morris was charged with one count of Registration of Online Identifiers, a Class B Felony.

Morris was convicted of a felony level Sexual Assault in the 9th Circuit Court in Kissimmee, Florida on December 12, 1988. Based on that conviction, Morris is required to register semi-annually as a Tier II Sex Offender for the remainder of his life.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Paul Morris was released on \$240 cash only bail and is awaiting his arraignment on April 12, 2018.
