On February 24, 2017 at approximately 6:44 P.M. members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Amy Haven, aka: Ashton Haven, age 28, of 120 Monroe Street, Nashua, New Hampshire, for Financial Exploitation of an Elderly, Disabled, or Impaired Adult, Class A Felony.

On January 24, 2017 detectives from Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division initiated an investigation into possible neglect and financial exploitation of an elderly female residing in Nashua. Through the investigation it was determined the victim was financially exploited by Amy Haven, aka: Ashton Haven, who is the victim's grandchild. The dollar amount exceeds \$35,000.00 of which Haven used for Haven's own personal benefit. Based on the investigation, detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Haven. Haven was subsequently arrested and charged with Financial Exploitation of an Elderly, Disabled, or Impaired Adult a Class A Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Haven was held on \$5,000 Cash bail pending arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on February 27, 2017.
