On June 19, 2017 at approximately 10:22 am, members of the Uniform Patrol Division arrested Kane Bloomfield, Age 32, of 14 Claremont Street, Apartment 13, Worcester, Massachusetts on a warrant for Theft by Deception, Class A Felony.

On December 16, 2016, members of the Billerica, Massachusetts Police Department received a complaint that from a local business that three unauthorized checks had been cashed at two banks in Massachusetts and a third bank in Nashua, NH. The value of the fraudulent check cashed in Nashua was \$2,491.11 dollars. Detectives from Billerica, Massachusetts identified Kane Bloomfield as the suspect and alerted Nashua Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division. Detectives from the Nashua Police Department completed an arrest warrant charging Kane Bloomfield with one count of Theft by Deception, Class A Felony. Kane was apprehended in Worcester, Massachusetts on May 10, 2017 and extradited to New Hampshire on June 20, 2017.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Bloomfield refused bail and he will be arraigned at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on June 20, 2017.
