

Registrations Open for NPD 29th Citizens Academy

9-Week Program Begins September 7th

Nashua Police Chief Andrew Lavoie announced today that registration for the department's 29th annual Citizens Police Academy are now being accepted.

The nine-week program begins on Thursday, September 7 and will be run from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. on consecutive Thursdays concluding on November 1.

Featured will be presentations by the department specialty units; Hazardous Device, SWAT and K-9. Two evenings will be devoted to the Detective Bureau and Crime Scene team. A Mock trial will be held during the session with the Legal Bureau and attendees will meet with the Chief Executive Officers, as well as hear about the department's accreditation process.
