On February 27, 2018, at approximately 7:03 PM, Detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division, arrested Randolph Leroy, age 28, of 386 Maple Street, Apartment 2, Manchester, New Hampshire on a warrant for Duty to Report, Class B Felony.

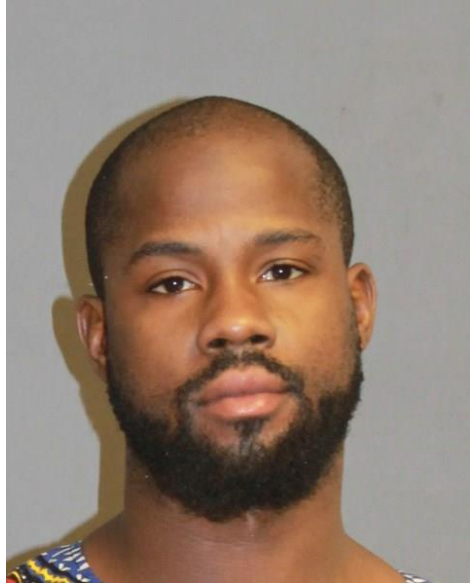
The Nashua Police Department discovered a convicted Sex Offender had failed to complete his semi-annual Sex Offender Registration as required. An investigation was initiated by the Special Investigations Division and it was verified that Randolph Leroy, missed his semi-annual Sex Offender Registration. As a result, Leroy was charged with one count of Duty to Report, a Class B Felony.

Leroy was convicted of Sexual Assault in Hillsborough County Superior Court South in Nashua, New Hampshire on November 16, 2009. Based on that conviction, Leroy is required to register semi-annually as a Tier I Sex Offender for ten years.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Leroy was released on \$200 cash bail pending his arraignment on March 15, 2018.
