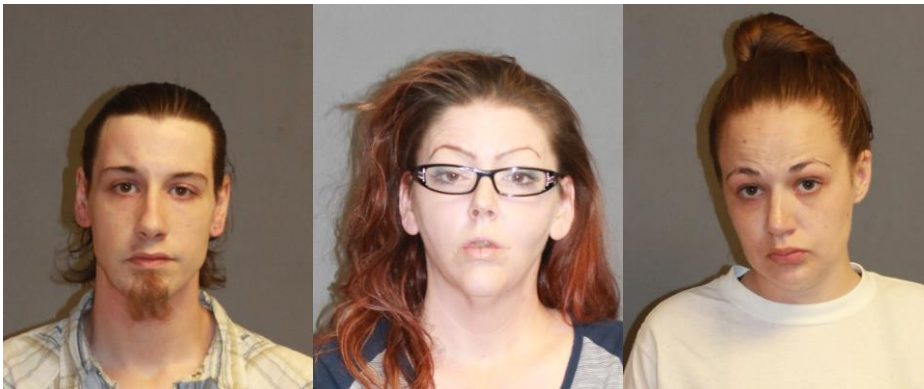

On May 01, 2018, members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division, Problem Oriented Policing Unit, and Traffic Enforcement Unit participated in Operation Granite Shield where three individuals were arrested for various drug crimes, and various crimes frequently associated with criminal behavior related to drug activity. These individuals were: Jeremy Storer, Holly Albino Rodriguez, and Lindsey Tierno.

Jeremy Storer, age 29, of 6.5 Underhill Street, Nashua, NH, was arrested and charged with two counts of Acts Prohibited; Sale of Controlled Drug, Heroin, Second Offense, Felony. Storer was held on \$50,000 cash only bail and is scheduled for arraignment on May 02, 2018.

Holly Albino Rodriguez, age 36, of 10 Demanche Street, Nashua, NH, was arrested and charged with one count of Acts Prohibited; Possession of Controlled Drug, Crack Cocaine, Felony. Rodriguez was held on \$10,000 cash only bail and is scheduled for arraignment on May 02, 2018.

Lindsey Tierno, age 28, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, NH, was arrested on a warrant for Probation Violation. Tierno was held without bail and is scheduled for arraignment on May 02, 2018.
