On April 5, 2018, at approximately 1:58 PM, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau, Patrol Division, arrested Jeffrey Allen, age 51, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Duty to Inform, Class A Felony.

During the course of the investigation, the Nashua Police Department discovered a convicted Sex Offender had moved from an address in Nashua to another address in Manchester, New Hampshire without properly updating his Sex Offender Registration information. An investigation was initiated by the Special Investigations Division. Following the Detective's investigation, it was determined that Allen failed to report a change to his information as required. Allen was charged with one count of Duty to Inform, a Class A Felony.

Jeffrey Allen was convicted of Felonious Sexual Assault in Rockingham County Superior Court on November 8, 2000. Based on that conviction, Allen is required to register quarterly as a Tier III Sex Offender for the remainder of his life. Allen has also been convicted of Duty to Report on August 8, 2017 from Hillsborough Superior Court North in Manchester, New Hampshire. Thus, any subsequent offense of Duty to Report or Duty to Inform is a Class A Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Jeffrey Allen refused bail and is being held at the Valley Street Jail pending his arraignment on April 6, 2018.
