On Wednesday, August 30, 2017 at approximately 6:00 pm, officers arrested Jason Noury, age 41, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, New Hampshire for Criminal Trespass, Class A Misdemeanor.

On August 30, 2017 at about 5:45pm, officers made contact with Jason Noury at a residence. It was discovered that Noury was trespassed from this location and he was subsequently placed under arrest. During the investigation, patrol officers learned that earlier in the day Noury had stolen clothing items from JC Penney at the Pheasant Lane Mall. The stolen property was recovered by patrol officers and a second charge of Theft by Unauthorized Taking, Class A Misdemeanor, was added.

Members of the Criminal Investigation Division furthered the investigation and learned that Noury had two previous theft-related convictions on his criminal record. Due to Noury's previous convictions, detectives upgraded his charge to Theft by Unauthorized Taking (Third Strike), Class B Felony.

A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the County House of Correction, exclusive of fines. A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Noury refused bail and was held at the Hillsborough House of Corrections and will be arraigned at the 9th Circuit Nashua District Division Court on Thursday August 31, 2017.
