On January 24, 2018 at approximately 5:16 PM, Detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigation Division, arrested Emmanuel Vazquez, age 24, of 65 Belmont Street, Merrimack, New Hampshire on a warrant for Registration of Online Identifiers, Class B Felony.

The Nashua Police Department learned that a convicted Sex Offender sent a juvenile a Facebook message in Nashua without listing his online identifier on his Sex Offender Registration. An investigation was initiated by the Special Investigations Division. Following the investigation, it was determined that Vazquez failed to report two online identifiers to his Sex Offender Registration as required and a warrant was obtained for his arrest. Vazquez was charged with two counts of Registration of Online Identifier, a Class B Felony. Upon Vazquez' arrest, it was also learned he was no longer living in Nashua as was reported on his Sex Offender Registration. As a result, he was also charged with Duty to Inform, a Class B Felony.

Vazquez was convicted of two counts of Sexual Assault in Hillsborough Superior Court South in Nashua, New Hampshire on March 5, 2014. Based on that conviction, Vazquez is required to register semi-annually as a Tier II Sex Offender for the remainder of his life.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Emmanuel Vazquez was released on \$300 cash only bail and is awaiting his arraignment on February 15, 2018.
