On Saturday, March 17, 2018 at approximately 2:14pm, officers arrested Julio Lopez, age 32, of 24 Lance Ave, Litchfield, New Hampshire. He was arrested on a Class B Felony theft related warrant from Salem, NH Police Department. Lopez was also charged with five counts of Theft by Unauthorized Taking, 2 Prior convictions, Class B Felonies, and two counts of Receiving Stolen Property, 2 prior convictions, Class B Felony.

On March 17, 2018 at approximately 1:00 pm officers responded to the area just outside of Macy's, located at 310 Daniel Webster Highway, where they made contact with Lopez who was a suspect in several thefts from Costco, 311 Daniel Webster Highway. Upon making contact with Lopez, Officers discovered that he had the warrant for his arrest out of the Salem Police Department. Incident to Lopez's arrest, Lopez was found to be in possession of stolen property from both the Apple Store and Macy's. Both stores are located within the Pheasant Lane Mall. Detectives from the Criminal Investigations Division furthered the investigation and identified Lopez as the suspect involved in a series of thefts from Costco over a period of two months. Detectives reviewed Lopez criminal history and discovered that Lopez had two previous theft related convictions, elevating Lopez's theft charges to felonies, five (5) counts of Theft by Unauthorized Taking, 2 prior convictions, Class B Felony, and two counts of Receiving Stolen Property, 2 prior convictions, Class B Felony.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Lopez refused bail and will be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court South on March 19, 2018.
