On February 22, 2018 members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau, Patrol Division, arrested Tabitha Reilly, age 30, from 218 Abbott Farm Lane, Hudson, New Hampshire for Robbery , Class B Felony.

On February 22, 2018 the Nashua Police Department received a report alleging Reilly took a wallet by force from a person known to her in the City of Nashua. After taking the wallet, Reilly fled the scene and struck another vehicle. Reilly fled the accident scene without providing the other operator her identification as well. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation. As a result, Reilly was also charged with Conduct After An Accident, Class A Misdemeanor.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Each Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to one year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Reilly was released on \$2000.00 Personal Recognizance bail and her arraignment date was later scheduled at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on March 18, 2018.
