On July 21, 2017 4:05 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Martin De Los Santos, age 41, of 28 Railroad Square Nashua, New Hampshire on an arrest warrant for Endangering the Welfare of a Child, a Class A Misdemeanor.

On July 21, 2017 the Nashua Police Department received a report that two fourteen year old girls were tattooed by De Los Santos. Subsequent investigation by the Uniform Field Operations Bureau led to the arrest of De Los Santos. At the time of his arrest, De Los Santos was charged with an additional count of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Class A Misdemeanor and one count of Sexual Assault, Class A Misdemeanor.

On July 22, 2017 members of the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation. Detectives determined that De Los Santos engaged in a sexually explicit conversation with one of the juveniles via a messaging app. and that there were additional incidents of sexual assault committed by De Los Santos. As a result, De Los Santos was charged with the following additional offenses: two counts of Sexual Assault, Class A Misdemeanor; one count of Certain Use of Computer Services Prohibited, Class B Felony; and one count of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Class B Felony.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Each Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the Count House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Martin was held on \$2,500.00 cash bail pending his arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on July 24, 2017
