On September 10, 2022, at approximately 4:15 AM, Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to a hospital in Massachusetts where they were notified of a sexual assault against a juvenile that occurred in Nashua. Detectives within the Special Investigations Division were assigned to the case and learned that the victim was sexually assaulted by a person known to the juvenile, Jhonathan Vincent, age 33, of Worcester, Massachusetts. Based upon the results of the investigation, an arrest warrant was issued for Vincent for Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault – Domestic Violence. He was also charged with Second Degree Assault – Domestic Violence as a result of the investigation

On September 16, 2022, at approximately 9:06 PM, Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit arrested Jhonathan Vincent without incident on the active warrant.

A Felony is punishable by a term of imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Vincent was released on \$5,000 cash bail and scheduled to be arraigned at Hillsborough County Superior Court – South later on in October.
