On November, 19, 2020, Nashua Police Patrol Officers arrested Alexis Casey, age 19, of 1 Collins Way, Dixfield, Maine on an outstanding warrant for Falsifying Physical Evidence - Class B Felony.

On July 17, 2020, officers responded to St. Joseph's Hospital for the report of a male with a gunshot wound to his foot. Detectives with the Criminal Investigation Division furthered the investigation with patrol officers and determined that the male had accidentally shot himself. During the course of the investigation it was then learned that Casey had hidden the firearm at another location, and provided false information to investigating officers. Casey was additionally charged with False Report to a Law Enforcement Officer – Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the Hillsborough County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Casey was released on \$290 Cash Bail pending her arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court South at a later date.
