The Nashua Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the following male who was involved in a suspicious incident that occurred outside the Pheasant Lane Mall at 310 Daniel Webster Highway on Sunday February 3, 2019. At approximately 3:00 pm, Nashua Police responded to the lower level of the parking garage in the rear of the mall between Target and Macy's in reference to a report that a male approached a female from behind and assaulted her as she was loading items into her vehicle. The victim reported the suspect placed one hand over her mouth and the other on her waist. The suspect fled on foot after the victim screamed and physically confronted the suspect. Detectives with the Criminal Investigation Division are furthering the investigation. The victim was not injured during this incident.

The suspect is described as a black male, average height and build, wearing a black jacket, jeans and a winter hat.
