On July 20, 2017 at approximately 7:16 PM, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau, Patrol Division, arrested Joseph Travis, age 48, of 70 Chestnut Street, Apartment B, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Duty to Inform, Class A Felony.

During a routine compliance check on Registered Sexual Offenders who reside in Nashua by detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division in July of 2017, it was determined that Joseph Travis had failed to comply with the terms of the Sex Offender Registry. Following the Detective's investigation, it was determined that Travis failed to report changes to his information as required in June 2017 and a warrant was obtained for his arrest.

Travis was convicted of Rape in Middlesex Superior Court in February of 1993. Based on that conviction, Joseph is required to register quarterly as a Tier III Sex Offender for the remainder of his life. Travis was convicted of Failing to Register as a Sex Offender in Boston Municipal Court in December of 2012. As a result of this conviction, any subsequent Duty to Report or Duty to Inform offense is classified as a Class A Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Joseph Travis was arraigned on July 21, 2017 and is being held at Valley Street Jail on \$20,000 cash or surety bail pending his next court date.
