On January 14, 2017 at approximately 9:21pm, members of the Uniform Patrol Division arrested Brandon Mason, Age 26, of no fixed address for Robbery, Class A Felony.

On January 14, 2017 at approximately 12:12 am, members of the Uniform Patrol Division responded to 23 Temple Street for a stabbing. The victim reported that an unknown male entered his apartment and threatened to stab him if he did not give him money. The victim tried to fight off the attacker and suffered two stab wounds during the altercation. The suspect then fled and the police were called. The victim sustained non-life threatening injuries and was treated at a local hospital for his injuries. Members of the Criminal Investigation Division furthered the investigation and identified Brandon Mason as the suspect. Mason was arrested and charged with Robbery, Class A Felony, two counts of First Degree Assault, Class A Felony, and Convicted Felons, Class B Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years in New State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years in New Hampshire State Prison, exclusive of fines. Mason was arraigned at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on January 17, 2017. His bail was originally set at \$100,000.00 cash and his probable cause hearing is scheduled for January 30th, 2017 at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court.
