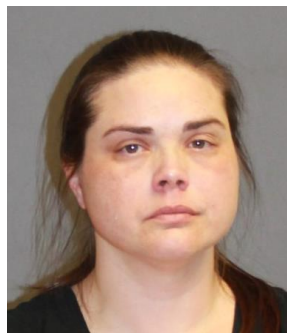

On February 16, 2017 at approximately 4:10 pm, detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division arrested Aimee Busby, age 40, of 56 Lund Road Apartment # B, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Second Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony.

On February 13, 2017 the Nashua Police Department received a report of a juvenile who was physically assaulted by the juvenile's mother several days prior. The report was forwarded to the Special Investigations Division and the investigation was furthered by detectives. It was determined the victim, age 12, was strangled by her mother, identified as Aimee Busby, in Nashua. The victim did not sustain serious injury from the assault. On February 16, 2017 detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant charging Busby with Second Degree Assault- Domestic Violence, Class B Felony. Busby was arrested the same day without incident.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Aimee Busby was released on \$1500.00 cash bail and is scheduled to be arraigned in the 9th Circuit – District Division – Nashua Court on February 17, 2017.
