On September 23, 2022, at approximately 7:59pm, Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniformed Field Operations Bureau arrested Keith Bernasconi, age 42, of Nashua, New Hampshire for two (2) of counts Attempted Felonious Sexual Assault, Class B Felony and Breach of Bail, Class A Misdemeanor.

On September 21, 2022, at approximately 4:44 p.m., Officers received a report of an unidentified male making lewd gestures towards two (2) juvenile females as they ran through Mine Falls Park. Officers searched the area but were unable to locate the male with the description that was provided. On September 22, 2022, at approximately 4:25 p.m., Officers received a similar call for service concerning a male making lewd comments and gestures towards two (2) other juvenile females as they walked through Mine Falls Park. The females provided a similar description of the male involved in the previous day's incident.

Officers searched the area and located Bernasconi, who matched the physical descriptors provided by the females. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation and an arrest warrant was issued for two counts of Attempted Felonious Sexual Assault. Furthermore, it was discovered that Bernasconi was out on bail for a previous lewd/indecent exposure-related crime and was charged with Breach of Bail, a Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable by a term of imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to 1 year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Bernasconi was held on preventative detention and is scheduled to be arraigned at Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on September 26, 2022.
