On December 7, 2016 at approximately 2:45 pm, patrol officers responded to a report of a domestic disturbance in Nashua. Curtis Gomez, age 30, of 110 Alban Street Apt. 1, Dorchester, MA was identified as the suspect in the investigation however he was not located at that time.

The investigation was furthered by Detectives assigned to the Special Investigation Division. The female victim, known to Gomez, reported Gomez assaulted her at a residence in Nashua as well as damaged a picture frame and stole an iPad 2 from that same location. During the time of the assault the victim was punched in the face and had her mouth and nose covered which impeded her breathing. The victim received non-life threatening injuries from the assault. Upon receipt of the information reported by the victim and another witness, Detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant that charged Gomez with Second Degree Assault – Domestic Violence. On January 12, 2017 at approximately 6:58 pm Gomez was arrested on the warrant without incident at the Plymouth Massachusetts House of Corrections.

Gomez was charged with Second Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony; Second Degree Assault, Class B Felony; 4 counts of Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor; 4 counts of Domestic Violence, Class A Misdemeanor, and Theft by Unauthorized Taking Class A Misdemeanor.

Gomez's bail was set at \$50,000 cash only. Gomez will be arraigned at the 9th Circuit - District Division-Nashua Court on January 13, 2017. A Class B Felony is punishable by up to one to seven years in Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Follow Nashua Police on Twitter @NashuaPolice
