On June 18, 2018 at approximately 9:55 a.m., Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniformed Field Operations Bureau arrested Jason Dow, age 46, of No Fixed Address for Second Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony.

On June 17, 2018 at approximately 6:11 am, Officers responded to an address in Nashua for a report of a domestic dispute. The investigation was furthered by Detectives from the Special Investigations Division. A female victim known to Dow reported that Dow assaulted her numerous times and he would not allow her to leave. The victim and Dow were treated at local hospitals for non-threatening injuries. Dow was subsequently charged with Second Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony; Criminal Restraint, Class B Felony; and five counts of Domestic Violence, Class A Misdemeanor.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Each Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to one year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Dow is being held at the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections on \$50,000 cash bail, pending his arraignment on June 19, 2018.
