On October 12, 2017 at approximately 2:31 am, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Jacob Finley, age 21, of 32 Hanover Street, Nashua, New Hampshire and charged him with Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony.

On October 12, 2017 at approximately 1:53 am, members of the Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to a downtown residence for a criminal threatening complaint. The victim reported that a relative threatened to stab them with a pair of scissors during an argument over the use of a parking space. The victim did not suffer any injuries during the incident and as a result of their investigation patrol officers arrested Jacob Finley at the scene. Detectives from the Special Investigation Divisions furthered the investigation and determined that Finley would be charged additionally with one count of Criminal Threatening-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony and two counts of Criminal Threatening, Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class A misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in jail, exclusive of fines. Finley was released on \$5,000 cash bail pending his arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on October 26, 2017.
