On Wednesday April 10, 2019 at approximately 11:45 am, officers arrested Kelly Aubut, age 47, of 38 Bell Street, Nashua, New Hampshire, for one count of Second Degree Assault (Strangulation), Class B Felony.

On April 3, 2019 patrol officers made contact with a victim who reported a physical altercation with an unknown male on Bell Street. During the physical altercation the victim reported the suspect placed his hands around the victim's neck to the point they could not breathe. The victim sustained non-life threatening injuries and declined medical attention.

Detectives from the Criminal Investigation Division were notified of this incident and furthered the investigation. Aubut was identified as the suspect and a warrant for his arrest was obtained. On April 10, 2019 Aubut was placed under arrest and a second charge of Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor, was brought forward stemming from the same altercation.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven (7) years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one (1) year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Aubut was released on personal recognizance bail and is scheduled for arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court- Southern District on April 25, 2019.
