On June 30, 2018 officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Jairo Rodriguez, age 21, of Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for 2nd Degree Assault – Domestic Violence, Class B Felony.

On June 29, 2018 at approximately 8:27 pm, patrol officers responded to the lobby of the Nashua Police Department for a report of a domestic assault that occurred at a local residence. The victim, who is known to Rodriguez, reported that he assaulted her to include strangling her to the point where she felt her breathing was impeded. The victim sustained minor physical injuries. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation and Rodriguez was identified as a suspect.

At approximately 1:00 am the following morning Rodriguez was arrested. As a result of the investigation Rodriguez was charged with 2nd Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony, Reckless Conduct – Domestic Violence, Class B Felony, False Imprisonment, Class A Misdemeanor, Criminal Trespass, Class A Misdemeanor, Criminal Threatening, Class A Misdemeanor, and seven counts of Domestic Violence – Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Rodriguez was held on \$15,000.00 cash only bail and will be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court South on July 2, 2018.
