On May 20th, 2018 at approximately 6:40 AM, Officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau, Patrol Division, arrested John Gervais, age 18, of 43 Whipple Road, Newport, New Hampshire for two counts of Criminal Mischief, Class A Misdemeanor, two counts Resisting Arrest/Detention, Class A Misdemeanor and Possession of a Narcotic Drug: Cocaine, Felony.

At approximately 6:37 AM, the Nashua Police Department received a report of Criminal Mischief occurring at a downtown location. Upon arriving, responding Officers located three individuals in that area, one of which, Gervais, had paint on his hands. Upon further questioning, a foot pursuit ensued. Gervais was located and placed under arrest. Upon further investigation, it was reported that Gervais had provided a juvenile with cocaine on this morning. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division were notified and furthered. As a result, Gervais was charged with an additional count of Controlled Drug Act: Acts Prohibited, Felony.

Each Felony is punishable by a term of imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Each Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Gervais was held on \$5,000 cash bail pending his arraignment on May 21st, 2018.
