On January 5, 2017 members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division, Problem Oriented Policing Unit and Traffic Enforcement Unit conducted another operation as part of the Granite Hammer Operation where four individuals were arrested for various types of crimes. These individuals were:

Shayna McDonald, age 31, of 52 Kinsley St. 1st Floor, in Nashua was charged with one count of Possession of Crack Cocaine with Intent to Distribute-Second Offense and one count of Possession of Oxycodone Hydrochloride with Intent to Distribute-Second Offense after the completion of a search warrant on her residence yielded approximately 25 grams of Crack Cocaine and 20 Oxycodone Hydrochloride pills. McDonald was held on \$20,000 cash bail, pending her arraignment on January 6, 2017.

Marcus Persons, age 23, of 52 Kinsley St, in Nashua was charged with one count of Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug, Heroin-Second Offense and one count of Possession of a Controlled Drug-Marijuana. Persons was held on \$15,000 cash bail, pending his arraignment on January 6, 2017.

Lauren Munday, age 29, of No Fixed Address, in Nashua, was arrested on a Capias out of the Hillsborough South Superior Court, original charge being First Degree Assault. Munday was held without bail.

Joel Smith, age 31, of 41 Vine St, in Nashua for Possession of Marijuana with Intent to Distribute. Smith was held on \$50,000 cash or surety bail.

Each of the listed suspects will be arraigned on January 6, 2017 at the 9th Circuit District Division Nashua Court.
