During the week of January 09, 2023, members of the Hudson Police Department, Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office, Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division and the Problem Oriented Policing Unit participated in a coordinated round-up operating under Operation Granite Shield where eight (8) individuals were arrested for various drug crimes, crimes frequently associated with criminal behavior related to drug activity and other criminal offenses. These individuals were as follows:

Peter Hartwell, age 47, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, New Hampshire, was arrested for Possession of a Controlled Drug – Heroin/Fentanyl as well as two Electronic Bench Warrants which were issued for non-payment of fines. He was released on personal recognizance bail pending his future arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – Southern District.

Christopher Reinhold, age 50, of 28 Railroad Square Apartment #45, Nashua, New Hampshire, was arrested for four counts of Sale of a Controlled Drug – crack/cocaine, Possession of a Controlled Drug with Intent to Distribute – crack/cocaine and Possession of a Controlled Drug – clonazepam. He was released on personal recognizance bail pending his future arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – Southern District.

Tanner Wilkes, age 23, of 89B Pine Street, Nashua, New Hampshire, was arrested on an out-of-town warrant issued for Possession of a Controlled Drug. He was released on personal recognizance bail pending his future arraignment in the Cheshire County Superior Court.

Kerry-Ann Dovidio, age 49, of 130 Flagstone Drive Nashua, New Hampshire, was arrested for a non-appearance warrant out of Hillsborough County Superior Court – Southern District. She was released on personal recognizance bail pending her future arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – Southern District.

Charlene Ricci, age 33, of 261 West Hancock Street Manchester, New Hampshire, was arrested for an out-of-town warrant as well as two counts of Possession of a Controlled Drug (heroin/fentanyl and clonazepam). She was released on personal recognizance bail pending her future arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – Southern District.

Corey Oak, age 21, of 5 Cheney Drive Hudson, New Hampshire, was arrested for Reckless Conduct with a Deadly Weapon, Criminal Threatening with a Deadly Weapon, Falsifying Physical evidence, and Criminal Mischief. He was released on cash bail pending his future arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – Southern District

Corey Jordan, age 29, of 111 Ferry Street Hudson, New Hampshire was arrested on Bail Jumping and seven Electronic Bench Warrants. Jordan was released on cash bail pending his future arraignment in the 9th Circuit District Division – Nashua Court.

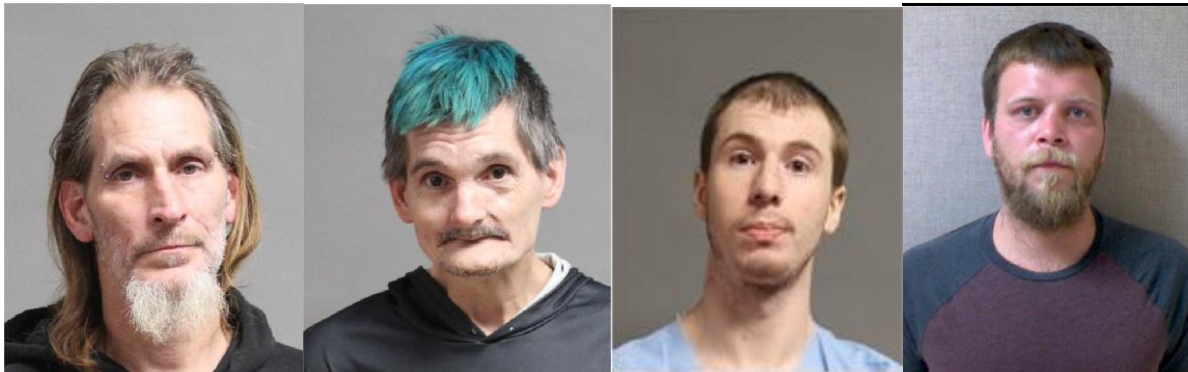
