On February 15, 2017 at approximately 5:32 pm officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Thomas Fallon, age 48, of 39 Sterns Road, Amherst, NH and charged him two counts of Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor; two counts of Domestic Violence, Class A Misdemeanor; Theft by Unauthorized Taking, Class A Misdemeanor and Stalking, Class A Misdemeanor.

On February 15, 2017 at approximately 3:00pm officers responded to a residence in Nashua for a report of a domestic disturbance. Upon arrival officers determined Fallon assaulted a woman known to him and fled the residence. The woman reported Fallon pushed her, punched her and stole some of her medication while he was in the residence. Officers also determined Fallon had bail conditions that prohibited him from having contact with the woman. The woman was treated at a local hospital for non-life threatening injuries. Fallon was later located and placed under arrest.

The investigation was furthered by officers assigned to the Nashua Police Domestic Violence Unit. A review of Fallon's criminal record revealed he was previously convicted of Domestic Violence – Stalking in 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit – District Division – Milford Court in September of 2015. Because of Fallon's previous conviction for stalking, the stalking conviction for this offense was upgraded to a Class B Felony.

Fallon's bail was set at \$25,000.00 cash only. Fallon is scheduled to be arraigned at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court – District Division – Nashua Court on February 16, 2017. A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Follow Nashua Police on Twitter @NashuaPolice.
