On Thursday March 16, 2017 at approximately 3:00 pm members of the Problem Oriented Policing Unit were on patrol and observed suspicious activity in the parking lot area of the Arel Manor Apartments, located at 165 Pine Street. The POP Unit viewed a male suspect breaking into and then entering a parked vehicle. As the POP Unit made contact with the suspect, who was now sitting in the driver's seat of the vehicle, the suspect rammed the POP Unit's police vehicle several times in order to escape. Members of the POP Unit attempted to stop the suspect however the suspect fled the area in the stolen motor vehicle. The vehicle was last seen on West Hollis Street in the area of Exit 5. No one was injured during this incident although the suspect did almost strike one of the POP Unit officers with the stolen vehicle.

The Criminal Investigation Division was notified and furthered the investigation. The suspect is described as a white male with unshaven facial hair. He is approximately 6 feet tall and has a medium build. He was wearing a winter hat, a red hooded sweatshirt, grey jacket, dirty work style pants and dark colored boots. The suspect was viewed walking south on Pine Street in the area of Gilman Street prior to this incident. The stolen vehicle is silver 1997 Honda Accord with a black hood bearing NH registration 401 3661.
