On November 5, 2018 at 9:15am, officers arrested John Scott Tully, 50, of 3 Sagamore Trail, Littleton, Massachusetts, for one count of Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer Consolidation, Class A Felony. Tully turned himself into the Nashua Police Department and was placed under arrest without incident.

On July 26, 2018 at 11:17am officers responded to National Tire and Battery at 298 Daniel Webster Highway, Nashua, New Hampshire for a report of an internal Theft. Through a subsequent investigation it was discovered that through a course of conduct John Scott Tully had stolen approximately \$7,900.00 from National Tire and Battery. A warrant was issued for Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer Consolidation, Class A Felony, for Tully.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Tully was released on Personal Recognizance bail and is scheduled to be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on November 15, 2018.
