Back on July 2, 2015 at approximately 11:28am, members of the Nashua Police Department Uniform Field Operations Bureau were dispatched to Bellwether Credit Union, 409 Amherst Street for a report of an armed robbery. Upon arrival, it was learned that two subjects armed with handguns and wearing masks over their face demanded two bank employees onto the ground and then demanded the money out of the teller drawers. The two suspects received an undisclosed amount of money and subsequently exited the bank. The bank employees were not injured during the time of the robbery.

Members of the Criminal Investigation Division were then assigned to further this investigation. After a lengthy and involved investigation Corey Cholette, age 28, of 21 Roberts Rd, Rochester, New Hampshire was identified as the suspect. On January 24, 2017 Detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Corey Cholette charging him with Robbery, Class A Felony.

On January 26, 2017 the Brentwood, NH Police Department, CID Detectives and members of the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit arrested Corey Cholette in Brentwood, NH. Cholette was then transported back to the Nashua Police Department.

The investigation is ongoing regarding the second suspect.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Cholette's bail set at \$50,000 cash and will appear at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on January 27, 2017.
