On Saturday April 14, 2018 at approximately 4:16 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department Problem Oriented Policing Unit arrested Jaydin Irizarry, age 18, of 31 Salvail Ct. Apt. 202, Nashua, New Hampshire, on an arrest warrant for one count of Reckless Conduct, a Class B Felony. Irizarry was also charged with Acts Prohibited: Possession of Controlled Drug, Felony, and False Report to a Law Enforcement Officer, Class A Misdemeanor.

On March 14, 2018, the Nashua Police Department Uniformed Patrol Division made contact with Irizarry regarding a shooting. Detectives from the Criminal Investigations Division furthered the investigation and it was determined that Irizarry had lied to the officer regarding how the shooting occurred and he had also placed another subject in danger of seriously bodily injury. It was also discovered that Irizarry possessed a controlled drug.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Felony is punishable by a term of imprisonment, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to a year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Irizarry was released from the Nashua Police Department on April 14, 2018 on \$1,000 personal recognizance bail and is scheduled for an arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on May 3, 2018.
