On December 5, 2017 at 5:19pm, members of the Nashua Police Department Problem Oriented Policing Unit arrested Justin Spencer, 30, of 1 Salvail Ct, Apt 3, Nashua, NH, charging him with 2 counts of Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer, Class B Felony, and 3 counts of Fraudulent Use of a Credit Card, Class A Misdemeanor.

Between October 29, 2017 and November 19, 2017 Spencer stole a cell phone, approximately \$920.00 in US currency, and two debit cards from victims that live within the city of Nashua. Having possession of the two debit cards, Spencer then proceeded to use the debit cards at various locations within the City of Nashua purchasing miscellaneous items that totaled approximately \$200.00. Spencer had two prior theft related convictions making these offenses Class B Felonies. An arrest warrant was obtained for Spencer.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to 1 year in jail, exclusive of fines. Spencer is being held on \$5,000.00 cash bail at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections in Manchester NH pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough Superior Court-South on December 6, 2017.
