On March 23, 2020 at 9:47 p.m., members of the Nashua Police Department arrested Charles Carroll, age 57, of 47 Hunt Street, Nashua, New Hampshire. Carroll was charged with two counts, Reckless Conduct – Class B Felony.

On March 23, 2020 at 8:33 p.m., officers responded to the area of Hunt Street for the report of shots fired. After an initial investigation, Charles Carroll was identified as being involved and found to be in possession of a handgun. It was determined Carroll had recklessly fired a handgun multiple times from his rear porch at 47 Hunt Street into the ground in the backyard placing several nearby residents in danger. Hunt Street is within a compact residential neighborhood with homes in close proximity to one another. Carroll was taken into custody on scene. No one was injured during this incident. The firearm believed to be involved was seized. Detectives furthered the investigation.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years of imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Carroll was released on personal recognizance bail pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on April 30, 2020.
