On April 10, 2017 at approximately 8:49 PM members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Patrol Division arrested Erik Caron, age 25, of 34 Royal Crest Drive Apt 4, Nashua, New Hampshire, for Second Degree Assault, Class B Felony.

On April 10, 2017 at approximately 1:57 PM, the Nashua Police Department was notified of a domestic assault that had taken place at a residence in Nashua on April 9, 2017. A female reported she was assaulted in Nashua by Caron, her ex-boyfriend, during an argument. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation and determined Caron strangled the female, threatened her with a knife, and assaulted her when he struck her with his hand and when he threw an object at her head. The female sustained minor injuries.

Based on the investigation, detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant for Caron for Second Degree Assault, Class B Felony. Caron later turned himself into the Nashua Police Department on the warrant. Caron was also charged with Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony; Domestic Violence, Class B Felony; two counts of Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor; and two counts of Domestic Violence, Class A Misdemeanor.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Each Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Caron was held on \$25,000 cash bail pending his arraignment at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on April 11, 2017.
