On July 19th 2017 members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniformed Field Operations Bureau arrested Daniel Paige Jr., age 30, of 39A Caldwell Road, Nashua, New Hampshire for disorderly conduct.

On July 19, 2017 at approximately 7:34pm, officers responded to a local residence for a report of a disorderly person. The complainant, who is a relative of Page, reported that Paige brandished a knife and threatened to kill him during a verbal argument. The complainant also reported that Paige damaged an interior wall during the argument by throwing an object at the wall and then punching it. Officers encountered Paige outside of the residence and determined that he was still armed with a knife. Officers negotiated with Paige at this time and he continued to yell and swear at them. The officers were eventually able to take Paige into custody and he was transported to a local hospital for an evaluation.

Members of the Special Investigations furthered the investigation and determined that he would be charged with Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony, Domestic Violence –Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony, Criminal Mischief, Class A Misdemeanor, and Disorderly Conduct, Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State prison, exclusive of fines while a Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to one year in jail. Paige will be arraigned at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on July 20th 2017
