On March 14, 2018 at approximately 6:09 PM, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Police Unit, arrested Ernest Hardy, age 34, of 31 Manchester Street, Nashua, New Hampshire for Duty to Inform, Class B Felony.

The Nashua Police Department learned a convicted Sex Offender had moved out of an address in Nashua without properly updating his Sex Offender Registration information. An investigation was initiated by the Problem Oriented Police Unit. Following the Officer's investigation, it was determined that Hardy failed to report a change to his information as required. Hardy was charged with one count of Duty to Inform, a Class B Felony.

Hardy was convicted of Certain Uses of Computers Prohibited, a Class A Felony, from the Hillsborough County Superior Court South in Nashua, New Hampshire on July 11, 2016. Based on that conviction, Hardy is required to register semi-annually as a Tier II Sex Offender for the remainder of his life.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Ernest Hardy was being held on \$10,000 cash bail pending his arraignment on March 15, 2018 in Hillsborough County Superior Court South in Nashua, New Hampshire.
