On July 2, 2018 at approximately 7:50 p.m., Justin Contreras, age 29, of 106 Ledge Street second floor, Nashua, New Hampshire was arrested by the Nashua Police Department Patrol Division. Contreras was charged with one count of Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony.

On June 26, 2018, Nashua Police Officers were called to 106 Ledge Street second floor, for the report of a suicidal subject. Upon arrival Officers encountered Justin Contreras who was armed with a firearm. Contreras then threatened one of the Officers by pointing the firearm at the Officer. Contreras was shot by the Officer, treated at a local hospital and later transferred to Massachusetts General Hospital.

Detectives from the Criminal Investigation Division furthered the investigation. Based on the investigation an arrest warrant was obtained for Contreras. Contreras was located in Nashua during a motor vehicle stop and he was taken into custody without incident.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Contreras was released on \$500.00 cash bail, and will be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court - South on July 12, 2018.
