On October 5, 2018 at approximately 9:56 PM, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Levi Coltey, age 20, of Nashua, New Hampshire, for Domestic Violence (6 counts), Resisting Detention, and Simple Assault (3 counts) all Class A Misdemeanors.

On October 5, 2018, the Nashua Police Department responded to a location in Nashua for the report of a domestic assault. The victim, known to Coltey, stated he assaulted her to include choking her with his hand. Coltey, who had fled the location prior to the police arriving, was located and taken into custody. Subsequently, Detectives with the Special Investigations Division were notified. As a result of their investigation, Coltey was charged with Second Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony, in lieu of one of the original 6 counts of Domestic Violence-Simple Assault.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to 1 year in County Jail, exclusive of fines. Coltey is being held pending his arraignment at Hillsborough Superior Court South on October 10, 2018.
