On September 11, 2020 at 6:58 p.m., the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Nathan Bernard, age 40, of 6 Underhill Street, Nashua, New Hampshire 03060. Nathan was charged with Receiving Stolen Property, a Class A Felony, and two counts of Possession of a Controlled Drug; Subsequent Offense, a Class A Felony.

On September 4, 2020 at 7:37 a.m., the Nashua Police Department took a report of a theft of a motor vehicle which occurred during the overnight hours from a local business. At approximately 1:41 p.m., the stolen vehicle was observed travelling in the area of East Hollis Street being operated by a male with two passengers within. Officers were flagged down by a witness and ultimately located the vehicle. All three occupants fled the area.

Detectives with the Nashua Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division were notified and furthered the investigation. All three occupants of the vehicle were identified, with the driver being Nathan Bernard. An arrest warrant was completed charging him with Receiving Stolen Property. On September 11, 2020, officers located and arrested Bernard without incident. Bernard was found to be in possession of narcotic drugs. He was additionally charged with two counts of possession of a controlled drug after having previously been convicted of the same charge, upgrading this offense to a subsequent charge.

Each Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years of imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Nathan was held on \$500 cash bail pending his arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on September 14, 2020.
