On April 11, 2017 at 5:08 pm officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operation Bureau arrested Jason Trythall, age 34, of 21 Mulberry Street Apt. A, Nashua, NH, on a warrant for Second Degree Assault, Class B Felony.

On March 9, 2017 the Nashua Police Department received a report that a six year old child was assaulted by his father, Jason Trythall, in Nashua. Detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation and determined that Trythall caused an injury to the child. The injury was non-life threatening. Detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant for Trythall.

On April 11, 2017 the Nashua Police Department was notified that Trythall was in the custody of Merrimack, NH Police Department. Nashua Officers responded to Merrimack and took custody of Trythall and returned with him to Nashua Police Department where he was booked. Trythall was also charged with Second Degree Assault – Domestic Violence, Class B Felony.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Trythall was held on \$5,000 Cash bail pending his arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on April 12, 2017.
