On April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017 at approximately 8:35 PM members of the Nashua Police Department Uniform Patrol Division arrested Cheryl Donlon, 56, of 27 Intervale Street, Nashua, New Hampshire, for Receiving Stolen Property, a Class B Felony.

On April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017 Nashua Police Department Patrol Officers responded to Macy's, located at 310 Daniel Webster Highway for a report of a female shoplifting. Through surveillance video Officers were able to obtain the license plate number of the vehicle in which the suspect had fled.

Officers located the vehicle a short time later at Donlon's residence and made contact with Donlon. She was subsequently placed under arrest.

The Criminal Investigation Division was notified of the incident. A review of Donlon's criminal record revealed she had two prior theft convictions on her criminal record and as a result the Receiving Stolen Property charge was upgraded to a Class B Felony.

A class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Donlon was released on \$150.00 cash bail pending her arraignment at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit-Division Division-Nashua Court on June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
